Simply Worship

As its name suggests, in this informal service we follow a simple order of service with contemporary songs. We sit in a circle in the North Transept. We explore the Scriptures through sermon series on particular Books or themes from the Bible.

The theme over the next four months will be people from the Book of Acts.

River

We begin with refreshments (homemade cake!) and the opportunity to share conversation together. We sit informally, round small tables. The worship is informal and thematic. We explore the theme through music, discussion, prayer, bible teaching, reflections, creativity and sometimes we even go outside. Each River is slightly different..



Messy Church

We begin with activities based round a bible story or theme. These activities are creative, interactive, and fun – of course there is always something messy to try out, perhaps with food, or paint or clay! Our worship session retells the story, sometimes with a video, drama and active participation, we like everyone to be involved. We always have a worship song or two and these are accompanied by the participants with our percussion instruments. Messy Church finishes with a snack tea and the opportunity to get to know one another.
